**4. Discuss Make a Difference Day**

Glenn sent the corps an update on what they have been doing on the trails. Jordan, from the corps, sent an email back thanking them for the all the work done. Lance emailed his contact at the University of North Texas thanking them for their help.

Talked about maybe doing a “make a difference day” in the spring. Martha Braid has about 75 students that would like to volunteer. Talked about picking a date for the spring, as well as a backup date, in April. Earth day is April 22<sup>nd</sup>. Lance to reach out to everyone to see what dates work.

## **5. Discuss projects and events for 2016**

Helping with the Corinth Police 5k. Maybe hosting a kid’s fun run and handing out little trophies as they cross the finish line. Talked about maybe having part of the course be on the rails to trails and have the runners go through part of the trail. Lance is working on that with Lowell.

Lance wants the group to be more City orientated, what can they do more of? Getting Adopt a Street back up and running. Lance to get with Erin to help promote Adopt a Street.

Lance discussed that since the Corinth parkway was now open the group needs to make sure we have the signage looking good. He suggests maybe helping buying some flowers or something for around the marquee so that is up and looking good.

## **6. Update on new storage building**

ATV, so far they are under budget with that. Jason reported that KCB was approved to use the excess funds to purchase a storage building for the Public Works Shop.

## **7. Any new business**

Lance discussed some fallen branches along the creek that have caused some damage. Jason is going to look at getting some guys out there to look at getting them removed.

Lance brought up the fact that KCB needs more board members to grow the committee so they are able to do more things. Several members have attended Keep Texas Beautiful conference and brought back good information. Discussed being able to get grants to be able to do more, Cindy asked about taking grant writing class so she could write grants on behalf of KCB. Lance suggested going on KTB to see if there is a webinar on grant writing, getting with students at NTCT, UNT or TWU and see if they could do that as part of a class project.

Lance asked if Public Works was responsible for the beautification along 2499. Jason believes that TxDot is going to put it in. Lance said that they are putting in sprinklers systems, bushes which was all news to Jason

Lowell has given Lance the contact information for the City judge so that if someone is in financial struggle they can do volunteer time instead. There is currently no volunteer system in place but Lance is going to look into it. The group will have to go out there with them and guide them on what needs to be done. What are the requirements with the City, hard hats, vest etc.?

Lance asked if the crews could empty the trash cans by the small pond. There is a big 55 gallon drum that he asked if it could be replaced with a regular trash can. Jason said he would order a new can for the pond. Lance asked if one could be placed along the trail.

Glen confirmed that there is an account set up for KCB at Ace Hardware. Lance asked the group if anyone buys something to email Lance and Jason just to let them know. Jason asked for the group to make sure they get a copy of the receipts along with writing KCB on the top.

Lance asked who was over the budget, Jason said himself and Melissa. Lance asked when CWD was going to make their annual donation of \$6,000. Lance is going to get with Susan Barney to see when the donation is normally deposited.
