1. Approve February's Minutes

2. Discuss KCB 2016 goals

-Maintain two big events with UNT

-Support Corinth 5K PD run

-Have small work days throughout the year.

-Pick a project to do, maybe plant flowers at Police or Fire Department

-KCB is now over adopt a street. Get more people involved; get in touch with DATCU, Corinth Classical Academy, get a list of businesses from the Chambers. See if any of these groups would want to get involved.

-Who is going to maintain the flower bed in front of the marque, the City or KCB?

3. Discuss KCB/UNT Big Event, April 2nd

UNT big event from 9:00am -12:00pm. Lance has completed all the paperwork asking for 40 students that day.

4. Discuss Corinth PD 5K support

May 7th is the race. Race will start about 8:00 -8:30am. You can buy raffle tickets now, they are trying to sell a 1,000 tickets. Race will start/finish from Lake Dallas High School this year.

5. Update on CWD donation funds

Jason couldn't find the donation date. Lowell believes it is on the contract year, he believes it is in May.

6. Update on landscaping/mowing on 2499

With the help of a grant TX Dot installed it and the City is to maintain it.

7. Any new business

Boy Scouts to place bench along the trail. There are 3 benches at the shop that can be used to place along the trail.

Glen, asked if there will be a trailer for the ATV? Lance reported that they can look at getting one once the ATV and building have been purchased. The only way to get to the trails on the west side of 35 will be to load it into the current trailer. Jason suggested maybe getting ramps and load it in the back of a truck.

Lance reminded the group to send him their volunteer hours and trash bag counts so that the City can keep up with it. Lance will send this information to Jason.

Lowell reported that there is a two day grant writing seminar in Addison put on by TML. Suggested that Cindy go as she was wanting to get into writing grants for KCB. Lowell also said that KCB should look at TX Dot for grants that is where the money came from to do the 2499 project.

Trails on the west side, a lot of the area is still wet/under water. Glenn asked if there will be a trail access point from the Long Lake subdivision. Lowell reported that currently that development is on hold and that there are major leans on the property. Glenn ask who is responsible for Old Alton Bridge, the county. A few boards need to be replaced; Kristin is going to be in contact and see if that can be taken care of.

On the community trail, there is a guy who has screwed in ramps onto the logs. Lance, has been taken them out. The goal is to keep the trail as natural as possible. Lance is working on getting the ramp that he and Everett installed a few year ago out. Jason is going to work with Lance to get the trail reworked and back in shape. Lance to follow up with the City on a time and date on when to move the bridge. The City has been helpful in doing work on the trail to help with the erosion.

Glenn, over the last few weeks has noticed people walking in the creek along his property. His property crosses the creek. He has put up no trespassing signs but they just take them down. He is asking what the City can do, Jason is going to walk the property with Glenn to try and come up with an idea. Barbwire fence?

Lance needs help with mowing the outside of the pond closest to the trail, by Fritz lane.
