April 12, 2015

CALL TO ORDER:

Chairman Lance Hendrik called the meeting to order at 6:04pm

BUSINESS:

1. Approve October's Minutes

Alex Austin: concerned about proposals to changing parks, extremely concerned about horse trailers loading and unloading anywhere near Bluff Estates. Expressed concerns about changes being made in neighborhood without informing or asking citizens. Against creating a park in Bluff Estates as well as using eminent domain to use some residents property for designated areas for horse unloading/loading.

Joe: Agreed with Alex Austins comments. Felt that he and fellow neighbors are in the dark about plans. Concerned about additional traffic in the area, current parks being proposed, when they will be started and completed.

Lance: suggests that board members put this topic as one of the agenda items for the next meeting so that things can be discussed. Advised citizens to email Lance their information so that they can address the issues.

Lizzie: From Kensington Estates. Concerned about curve on Swisher Rd and the speeds that cars travel down that road and horse trailers turning into that area. Also would like to discuss a large lake clean up. Concerned about the amount of trash around the lake. Discussed the horse trails and how the rain will affect them and the area.

Glenn: Addressed Lizzie's concerns about the trash. Said that they have taken 120 bags of garbage out in the Bluffs. Said that in the past 2 weeks they have picked up 67 backs of trash along with other stuff. Kensington is next on the list for cleanup. Cleared up the horse trail concerns. The trail has been a horse trail for about 20 years and he has no knowledge of

that being changed. Some of the things he has heard about a parking lot on 2181 is news to him. He heard that the UTA study may have said that but doesn't know of anyone who has talked about putting a parking lot on 2181. No plans to put a horse trailer parking lot in the Bluffs.

Citizen: All information that they are getting about is from the UTA study. There is a two page map in which is shows a playground and parking lot for trailers to be put in a cul-de-sac between two houses. No one in that area is in favor of this.

Lance: Asks Jason Cao if he has any idea about the UTA study. Jason states that he has not seen it. But he will ask about it.

2. Recap of KCB UNT Event

Lance: over 60 people showed up. Over 100 trash bags. Thanks the City, UNT, Lake Dallas Middle School, Cub scout troop 103 for the support. Shows pictures of clean ups

Lance: Dates are May 7, 2016. Would like to see more come out and support more. Informs how you can volunteer.

Update:

Lance: Jason has quote on portable building. They have KCB Vehicle. Needs email of Jan.-Feb volunteer hours and trash bag counts

Glenn: Weed whacker and chain saw need to be replaced.

Lance: If someone wants to do a work day whenever they would like just give notice so that it can be advertised on the site

Cathy: Contacted and found an agency to do a class for Grant writing.

Lance: Update on lease renewal.

Glenn: City took over and hasn't heard anything.

Jason: Went had a meeting with the army engineer. Talked about what we have (150 acres) versus what we actually utilize. Shoreline maintenance and what the city would have to use to keep the 150 acres. Turned into a lot of things the city is not interested in. Right now the lease agreement is being redefined. Trying to gain more of a permit of a 5 year time period instead of yearly. Still in the works.

Cathy: Discusses concerns about policing the trails and who is responsible.

Glenn: thinks there is some agreement where the municipalities need to take care of it but is not sure because it is on the core property.
