



One Code Officer covers 8 square miles with a population of 20,000



## Human Resources – Forging a Strategic Partnership with City’s Management

### Performance Reviews

- All employees received performance feedback

### Merit Increases

- First merit increase awarded in 2014 with support of City Council

### Medical Insurance

- With assistance from Benefits Consultant, negotiated an 8% rate increase (down from 22% initial increase) saving City & employees \$200,000 annually.

### COMPASS – Health Services Advocate

- 34 employees were assisted
- Saving the plan and the employees \$23,941 in related costs
- Saved employees 213 hours of time (most likely working hours)

### Fire & Emergency Medical

- Provided to Corinth, Lake Dallas, Hickory Creek & Shady Shores.
- 3178 Calls for service in 2014.
- 86% of the calls required action on scene.
- Response time within 8 minutes 92% of the time; within 4 minutes 37% of the time.

### Collaborative Efforts

- Dispatch with Denton County Sheriff's Office.
- Medical Billing & Cost Recovery.
- Medical Control and Continuing Education.
- Specialized Mechanical Services.
- Gear Cleaning and Inspection.
- Ladder & Pump Certifications.

### Emergency Management

- Provide emergency response planning, training, and Emergency Operations Center to all 4 cities.
- Activate and maintain outdoor siren system.
- Serve as liaison to FEMA and other related agencies.

**Loyalty – to your firefighters, your dept. and the fire service**  
**Respect – treat everyone like family**  
**Courage – to do what is right**



### Fire & Life Safety Education

- Reached approx. 7500 children, pre-K to 3<sup>rd</sup> grade.
- Included LDISD, Charter School and Daycare Facilities.
- Teach basic behaviors to prevent injuries in the event of a house fire.

### Commercial Occupancy Inspections

- Inspected 561 businesses.
- 85% were compliant on 1<sup>st</sup> visit.
- 20 foster homes were inspected at request of CPS.

### Community Support

- Over 1830 Hours of staff hours spent providing public education, public appearances, ride out programs, and station tours.
