Warrant Round Up – Statewide Effort to Clear Warrants

CORINTH, TX - The Corinth Police Department and City of Corinth Municipal Court will be attempting to clear warrants totaling over \$3.2 million dollars by participating in a statewide warrant roundup March 5th-13th, 2016. Officers will allow people with outstanding warrants two weeks to dispose of their charges before law enforcement officers kick off the “Great Texas Warrant Round Up” campaign.

Law enforcement officials from across the state are urging people to take care of any outstanding warrants immediately to avoid being arrested at work, home or school.

The Corinth Police Department will begin their efforts on Saturday, March 5th when officers will start arresting people with outstanding warrants.

Notices by mail and phone have been sent to people with active warrants in the North Texas area, but the “Great Texas Warrant Round Up” initiative will not be limited to the Corinth, Denton, Hickory Creek, Lake Dallas and Lewisville areas.

To avoid arrest, people with active warrants are encouraged to go in person to the City of Corinth Municipal Court to make appropriate arrangements before the combined law enforcement effort begins statewide on March 5, 2016. Those wanting to confirm if they may have a warrant can call the City of Corinth Municipal Court at 940-498-3236.
