Subject: TCEQ Lead and Copper Notice of Violation

The City of Corinth is required by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) to collect and sample water for lead and copper levels. Corinth has met or exceeded all state requirements for water quality including all lead and copper samples and maintains a "Superior Water Rating" with the TCEQ.

In October 2016, the City submitted thirty lead and copper samples to a third party laboratory as required by the TCEQ. All thirty samples taken for lead and copper screening passed and exceeded requirements set by the TCEQ. Although the samples did pass the screening, three collection samples submitted did not include the collection times. Therefore, the entire test was considered invalidated by the TCEQ. Corinth will retest on June 1, 2017 as required by the TCEQ.

We are required by the TCEQ to notify all residents who purchase water from Corinth of the situation and inform them of the retesting in June of 2017. We must also use the TCEQ standard form and may not modify any language on the template. We have included this letter to provide more detail and to assure that the required samples were taken and met all State requirements.

We are committed to ensuring the quality of water and service in the City of Corinth and have worked with the laboratory, the TCEQ, and implemented new procedures to maintain our superior system. Should you have any questions, please Contact the Corinth Utility Department at **940-498-3253**.
