



Dr. T.A. Ball, a physician and a preacher, came to the Peters Colony, Denton County area, soon after the Civil War. He donated the first land for the cemetery, and named the place Shiloh. His daughter Alice Ball married Charles E. Fowler, son of the Thomas Jefferson Fowler family, who had come from Maysville, Kentucky, and settled in Corinth in 1864.



A second gift of land, 1.05 acres, was made to the cemetery on December 30, 1953, by J.L. Allison, a single man. This gift is recorded in Vol. 393, page 121, Deeds and Records, Gideon Walker Survey, Plot No. 1330. Trustees for the cemetery were R.E. Coleman, O.L. Fowler, and W.J. Crubaugh.









In 1959, the cemetery was called the Corinth-Shiloh Cemetery officially. This was done to distinguish it from other Shiloh-named cemeteries, and to help in locating the site. Mrs. Gladys Fowler Sullivan was the leader at this meeting, and the Corinth Shiloh Cemetery Association was formed.

A shelter was built.



A membership fee of \$5.00 was agreed upon. This fee was the beginning of a fund for perpetual care of the cemetery in the future. Occasional "work days" in which the community participated kept the cemetery looking well-tended and never forgotten.







On May 1, 1961, Mr. Rob Shahan was elected president, Albert Meadows, vice president, Alice Pockrus, secretary-treasurer, with Otis Taylor, and Jack Meadows, directors. The building committee was Marshall Webster, chairman, and Pete Pockrus, Aline Balka, and Joe Meadows.

Mr. Rob worked tirelessly for eighteen years as president of the Association. On the first Sunday in May of each year, an area-wide meeting was held at the shed. The day before was a work day, when citizens of the area worked all morning, enjoyed a delicious "pot luck" lunch, and readied the cemetery for the following day.



At 2:00 P.M., the first Sunday in May, a program included a Sing-Song, prayers, a visiting minister as speaker, and gifts for special attendants.

A plaque was tendered Mr. Rob in 1971, recognizing his devotion and loyalty. Mr. Rob Shahan died, April 11, 1985, and is buried in Corinth-Shiloh Cemetery, in a spot he loved.









Mrs. Thelma Meadows became president of the Association in 1979. Foy Taylor, vice president, Alice Pockrus, secretary-treasurer, and Ray Harris, and Bennie Jones, directors, were elected to serve with her. A name sign for the cemetery was agreed upon, and Foy Taylor designed it, and erected it. Mrs. Meadows died in 1980. The vice president finished her term, and was elected president in 1980. Other officers were Leon Brown, Pete Pockrus, Ray Meadows, and Beatrice Brown. Lula Taylor became program chairman. A gift of \$300.00 was made to the Association by the Corinth Bicentennial Committee in memory



of Mrs. Meadows. The work day was continued as needed, and the Cemetery always looked beautiful, peaceful, and well-remembered. The Willie Williams family brought barbecued beef, ham, and chicken to the "pot luck" lunch, and have continued this generous gift yearly. Everyone enjoys this thoughtful bonus.







Perpetual care has been the goal of the Cemetery Association for many years. Now, in the year of 1986, that goal has been reached. Many people have worked hard, and diligently, in this effort, and special recognition is given to Alice Pockrus. She has served the Association and the community well for the past twenty-seven years, as secretary and treasurer. All Corinth citizens offer her grateful thanks for her consistent dedication to this work.




There are 502 graves in the cemetery that have stones or markers that are easily identified. An additional 30 graves have markers but no recorded death date. Some of these unknown may have been buried elsewhere, or have not died yet. Many of the graves are marked with sandstone rocks, some with inscriptions on them. Some burial spots with no identifying marks were subjected to a metal detector. This work was done by Daniel Meadows of Corinth.



John Turner died while he was serving as pastor of the Corinth Baptist Church, from December, 1887, until his death on May 13, 1888. His headstone reads:

Some of the unmarked graves have a sandstone or brick.









Dr. T.A. Ball was born January 1, 1830. He died February 1, 1914. His wife, Nancy Yeats, was born February 19, 1831, and died February 19, 1910. She and Dr. Ball were married in 1848, and she united with the Primitive Baptist Church in 1852.

The Ball stone has large marble slabs at each end, with a tent of marble in the middle.



The oldest stone in the cemetery was on the grave of William Garrison, 1810-1870. There is a broken stone, sandstone, lying by the new stone with the following still visible WILL--- -----on
