CALL TO ORDER, INVOCATION, PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE:

BUSINESS AGENDA

<u>Section 551.072.</u> To deliberate the purchase, exchange, lease or value of real property if deliberation in an open meeting would have a detrimental effect on the position of the governmental body in negotiations with a third person.

<u>Section 551.074.</u> To deliberate the appointment, employment, evaluation, reassignment, duties, discipline, or dismissal of a public officer or employee; or to hear a complaint or charge against an officer or employee.

<u>Section 551.087.</u> To deliberate or discuss regarding commercial or financial information that the governmental body has received from a business prospect that the governmental body seeks to have locate, stay, or expand in or near the territory of the governmental body and with which the governmental body is conducting economic development negotiations; or to deliberate the offer of a financial or other incentive to a business prospect.

After discussion of any matters in closed session, any final action or vote taken will be in public by the City Council. City Council shall have the right at any time to seek legal advice in Closed Session from its Attorney on any agenda item, whether posted for Closed Session or not.

RECONVENE IN OPEN SESSION TO TAKE ACTION, IF NECESSARY, ON CLOSED SESSION ITEMS.

RESOLUTION NO. 19-05-14-01

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE CORINTH CRIME CONTROL AND PREVENTION DISTRICT OF THE CITY OF CORINTH, TEXAS, CANVASSING AND DECLARING THE RESULTS OF THE MAY 4, 2019 ELECTION HELD TO DETERMINE WHETHER THE CORINTH CRIME CONTROL AND PREVENTION DISTRICT SHOULD BE CONTINUED FOR TEN YEARS AND THE CRIME CONTROL AND PREVENTION DISTRICT SALES TAX SHOULD BE CONTINUED FOR TEN YEARS AND CONTINUE A LOCAL SALES AND USE TAX AT A RATE OF 1/4 OF ONE PERCENT (0.25%); AUTHORIZING THE CONTINUATION OF IMPOSITION OF THE TAX FOR A PERIOD OF TEN (10) YEARS; PROVIDING FOR THE INCORPORATION OF PREMISES; PROVIDING CONFIMRATION OF VOTE TABULATION; PROVIDING CANVASS; PROVIDING NOTICE, OPEN MEETINGS, AND SEVERABILITY CLAUSES; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on May 4, 2019, a special election was held in accordance with the provisions of the Texas Local Government Code and the Election Code for the purpose of determining whether the Corinth Crime Control and Prevention District should be continued and whether the crime control sales and use tax should be continued for an additional period of ten (10) years (the "Proposition"); and

WHEREAS, state law requires that the governing body of the Crime Control and Prevention District canvass all elections; and

WHEREAS, the official returns of the election on the Proposition, including returns of early voting ballots cast, of the presiding judges of the special election have been presented and delivered; and the Board of Directors of the Corinth Crime Control and Prevention District ("Board") acting in the capacity of the Canvassing Board has duly canvassed said returns in accordance with the law; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE CITY OF CORINTH CRIME CONTROL AND PREVENTION DISTRICT, CORINTH, TEXAS THAT:

SECTION 1. Incorporation of Premises

The findings set forth above are incorporated into the body of this Resolution as if fully set forth herein.

SECTION 2. Confirmation of Vote Tabulation

The Board officially finds and determines that at a special election held on May 4, 2019, the following proposition was submitted to the voters and the following votes were cast, and that based upon the votes cast, the following Proposition was approved:

WHETHER THE CORINTH CRIME CONTROL AND PREVENTION DISTRICT SHOULD BE CONTINUED FOR TEN YEARS AND THE CRIME CONTROL AND PREVENTION DISTRICT SALES TAX SHOULD BE CONTINUED FOR TEN YEARS.

SECTION 4. Canvass

The Board finds that said election was duly called, that notice of said election was given in accordance with state law, and that said election was held in accordance with state law, the results of the election as set forth above are correct, and the canvass of the votes are hereby ratified and approved to continue the district. Therefore, the Board orders that the Corinth Crime Control and Prevention District is hereby continued and a 1/4 cent sales tax is hereby authorized to continue.

SECTION 5. Notice

Upon adoption of this Resolution, the City Secretary is directed to immediately give notice of the election results concerning the proposition to the Texas Comptroller of Public Accounts and any other agency required by law.

SECTION 6. Open Meeting

It is hereby officially found and determined that the meeting at which this Resolution was passed was open to the public, and public notice of the time place, and purpose of said meeting was given, all as required by Article 551.041, Texas Government Code.

SECTION 7. Severability

Should any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this Resolution be declared unconstitutional or invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, it is expressly provided that any

and all remaining portions of this Resolution shall remain in full force and effect. Corinth hereby declares that it would have passed this Resolution, and each section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase thereof irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, sentences clauses and phrases be declared unconstitutional or invalid.

SECTION 8. Effective Date

This resolution shall be effective immediately upon and after its passage.
