

CONSERVATION EASEMENTS are voluntary, legal agreements between a landowner and a land trust or government agency that permanently limits uses of the land in order to protect its conservation values.



Application

Conservation easements offer flexibility. If the donation benefits the public by permanently protecting important conservation resources and meets other federal tax code requirements, it can qualify as a tax-deductible charitable donation.
